The hotel is on the left. ***From the North:*** Garden St Pkwy to exit 135, go straight to the second traffic light and make a left. Go through the next light and take the second exit to the right. The hotel is on the left.

Workshop description: Project-Based Learning (PBL) is both a curriculum and process approach to education. Through this approach, students assume increasing responsibility for learning through carefully selected and designed problems which promote acquiring critical knowledge, problem-solving proficiency, self-directed learning strategies, and team participation skills. The process helps motivate students, gives them a sense of accomplishment, and sets a pattern for them to become successful life-long learners. Participants explore the fundamentals of PBL, how to implement it in their classrooms, and appropriate ways to assess students.

**Registration: A \$10.00 deposit is required with your registration.** Each workshop requires a separate \$10.00 check per person.
